<b>Freedom of Navigation FY 07 Operational Assertions</b>	
<b>COUNTRY</b>	<b>MARITIME CLAIM CHALLENGED</b>
China*	Claims jurisdiction of superadjacent airspace over the exclusive economic zone; domestic law criminalizes survey activity by foreign entities in any waters under the jurisdiction of the coastal state.
India*	Requirement for prior consent for military maneuvers in the exclusive economic zone.
Indonesia*	Conduct of archipelagic sea lanes passage through normal passage routes used as routes for international navigation or overflight through or over archipelagic waters.
Iran*	Claims to restrict right of transit passage through Straits of Hormuz to Law of the Sea signatories.
Malaysia*	Requirement for prior authorization for nuclear-powered ships to enter the territorial seas; claim for requirement for prior authorization for military maneuvers in the exclusive economic zone.
Maldives*	Claim for requirement for all foreign vessels to obtain prior permission to enter the exclusive economic zone.
Oman*	Claims to recognize only the regime of innocent passage and not international transit passage through Strait of Hormuz.
Philippines*	Claim of archipelagic waters as internal waters.
